The use of FSC certified printing materials accompanied by Eco-Smart Inks by Braden Sutphin Ink Company., environmentally friendly solvents and fountain solutions with low VOC's. These products combined into one printing process can give our customers confidence and trust in the types of products they are distributing. Here at Robin Enterprises Co. we take the environment serious. In addition to the Green Printing Process mentioned, we currently have many different types of programs in place.

1. We currently recycle our press wash solvents on site. This has reduced the amount of products sent out as hazardous waste. Example, since 2002 we have reduced our hazardous waste by 95%. This was such a drastic change that we were highlighted in the EPA news letter. If you would like to see this article you can view it on the front page of our website.
2. The water that is removed from the solvent recycling is clean and reused within our facility reducing the amount of water and energy consumption.
3. We currently filter and reuse the heat generated from the presses to heat other parts of our facility.
4. All paper waste generated is sent out for recycling.
5. All printing plates are sent out for recycling.
6. Aqueous and solvent drums are sent back to the suppliers for reuse as opposed to being put into the landfills.
7. Our facility lighting is all green-tip and recycled.
